

## The Liturgy of Collective Worship at Westcott CE School

## Vision: 'Let your light shine before others' Matthew 5 v16

Pupils enter the Church	Music chosen by the collective worship committee in conjunction with the teacher who is leading the collective worship is played.
The Peace	After saying, "Good Morning," the teacher leading worship says, "The Peace of the Lord be with you."
Response	Everyone responds by saying, "And also with you."
The Greeting	A member of the collective worship committee or a pupil chosen by them will say, "Jesus the light of the world is here."
Response	Everyone responds by saying, "Lord Jesus Shine upon us."
Prayer	The Lord's Prayer is said.
The Learning	The teacher who is leading the collective worship then delivers the main teaching. This may be, but not limited to:
	<ul> <li>Bible stories</li> <li>A story from another faith</li> <li>A story</li> <li>Drama</li> <li>Poetry</li> <li>Sharing an image / artefact</li> <li>Pupils presenting</li> <li>Question – thinking – response time</li> </ul>
Response	The teacher leading collective worship then links the teaching to the value for the half term.
Song of praise	A hymn or worship song is sung – this is chosen by the teacher leading worship in conjunction with members of the collective worship committee
Prayer	A prayer said by the teacher leading collective worship or written by a pupil
The dismissal	A member of the collective worship committee or a pupil chosen by them will say, "Let the light of Christ shine in all our hearts."
Response	Everyone responds by saying, "Amen."
Pupils exit the Church	Music chosen by the collective worship committee in conjunction with the teacher who is leading the collective worship is played.
